Applicant Video Conference Interview Preparation and Procedure

The following applies to applicants of the NSU Tampa Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) program who have elected to conduct their admissions interview with faculty via video-conference.

1. What equipment and hardware is required?

- A computer (desktop or laptop), tablet, or mobile device
- Broadband Internet access
- A video cam (external recommended)
- A microphone (internal or external)
- Speakers or headphones

2. What software or programs are required?

- None. We will send you a link with a **GoToMeeting** invitation via email
- At the appropriate date and time of your interview, click on the link provided in the email message

3. System requirements in your computer:

A. For PC based participant

- Internet Explorer 9, Mozilla, Firefox 34, Google Chrome 39 (JavaScript enabled or the latest version of each web browser)
- Windows XP, Windows 2008 Server or later
- Cable modem, DSL, or better Internet connection
- Dual-core 2.4 GHz CPU or faster with 2GB of Ram (recommended)

B. For Mac-Based participants

- Safari 6, Firefox 34, Google Chrome 39 (JavaScript enabled or the latest version of each web browser)
- Mac OS X 10.8 (Mountain Lion) or newer
- Intel processor (2GB or RAM or better recommended)
- Cable modem, DSL, or better internet connection

C. Mobile devices

- Free GoToMeeting app from the App Store, Google Play, or Windows Store
