This includes the identification and engagement of interested partners and groups, the assessment of their needs, and the generation of products and tools that support management, adaptation, and resilience to ocean and coastal acidification. Padi Foundation	<a href="#">Grant</a>	Supports <b>research and education related to aquatic environments</b> . Focus areas: 1) Enrich mankind's understanding of aquatic environments and encourage sensitivity to and protection of ecosystems; 2) Increase understanding of sport diving physics and physiology that will benefit the general diving public and add to the scientific understanding of man's relationship and ability to survive in the underwater environment, and 3) Improve understanding of, and response to, hazards to humans and ecosystems related to climate change in coastal and ocean environments.	1/15/25
CDC - NIOSH	<a href="#">Commercial Fishing Occupational Safety Training Project Grants (T03)</a>	Provide funding to municipalities, port authorities, other appropriate public entities, not-for-profit organizations, and other qualified persons to conduct <b>commercial fishing vessel safety training</b> for vessel operators and crewmembers. Safety training courses could include the following topics: emergency drills, survival, damage control, fire prevention and firefighting, stability, seamanship, fatigue awareness and prevention, watchkeeping, and weather forecasting. The program is also authorized to provide funding for the purchase of safety equipment and training aids for use in those safety training programs.	1/28/25
